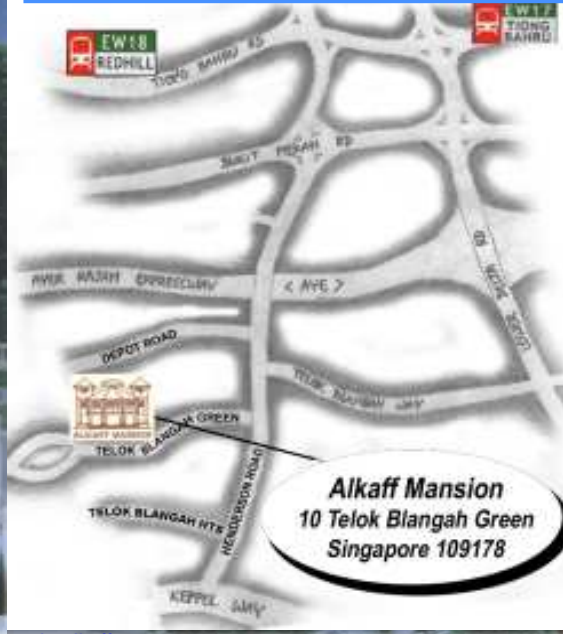
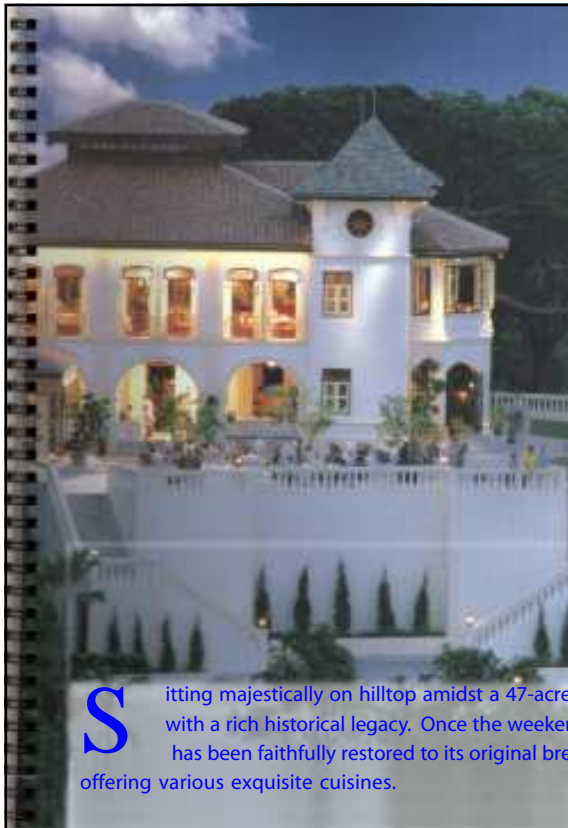
The Church of Our Lady of Perpetual Succour was started with a call for donations to build a church in the Siglap area in 1955. After much hard work, enough money was collected to buy land at Frankel estate by 1958, and by 1960 construction commenced. On 7th October 1961 the Church was opened for worship.

The parish saw steady growth, and by 1996 it was clear that OLPS Church needed to be upgraded, and a new superstructure was completed by August 1997. The presbytery was rebuilt in 1998-1999.

The Church you see today came in to being in 2000, with renovations that added Airconditioning, and seating space for 1,600 people and a building extension for offices, classrooms and AVA rooms.



The Reception



Sitting majestically on hilltop amidst a 47-acre park, Alkaff Mansion is a prestigious conservation property with a rich historical legacy. Once the weekend retreat of the wealthy Alkaff family in 1920s, the Mansion has been faithfully restored to its original breathtaking splendour, and is now a unique dining venue offering various exquisite cuisines.
